



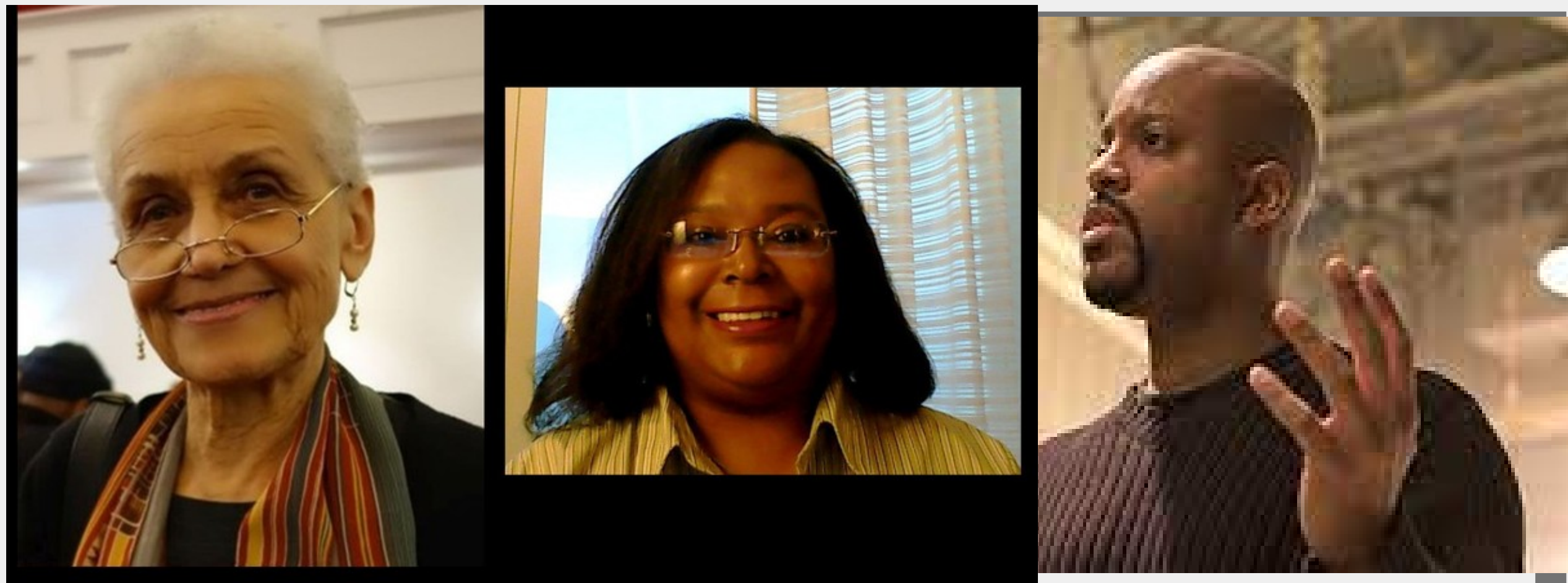

The Nine O'clock Whistle



Film Screening & Post Discussion with Co-directors Willa Cofield & Karen Riley

For years on Saturday nights, white authorities in Enfield, N.C. blew a siren-like whistle, warning Blacks to clear the downtown streets. This curfew was one of many demeaning practices used to keep the Black population separate and unequal. Through the narratives of Willa Cofield, her former students, and current residents of the town, “The Nine O'clock Whistle” tells the story of a dramatic cultural movement from 1963 to 1965 that rocked the segregated town and changed it forever.
