

## Undergraduate Student Admitted to 4-Plus Program (500-level)

## **Registration Approval Form**

## **Purpose:**

• Students who have been admitted into a 4-Plus program at Worcester State University have the ability to take a limited number of graduate courses which will count towards their undergraduate degree requirements. Later, when they fully matriculate into the graduate program at Worcester State, these classes will be renumbered and will apply towards the requirements for the master's degree. *This form should only be used for students who have been admitted into a 4-Plus program.* 

## Notes:

- These courses are 500-level courses and will be listed that way on the student transcript with a letter grade. When matriculated into the graduate program, the courses will show on the graduate transcript as 900-level courses with "TR" for transfer in place of a grade.
- Student pays the <u>undergraduate</u>, day rate for tuition and fees for these classes.
- Students are cautioned that graduate-level courses taken as part of their undergraduate major at Worcester State University may not transfer to other colleges as graduate credit.
- Some graduate courses may be excluded from this option. Students should work with their advisors to determine which classes they should take in the 4-Plus program.
