Undergraduate Student Taking a Graduate Course to Count Toward an Undergraduate Degree (600-level)

Registration Approval Form

Purpose:

• To provide Worcester State University undergraduate students the ability to take a graduate level course and have that course fulfill an undergraduate degree requirement. Senior undergraduate students may take 1 or 2 graduate-level courses, in their major area of study, before obtaining a bachelor's degree. (For example, biology majors can take graduate-level biology courses; English majors can take graduate-level English courses.)

Notes:

- In order to be eligible, undergraduate students must be in their senior year (have earned a minimum of 90 credits) and have a strong academic record.
- These courses are 600-level courses and will be listed that way on the student transcript with a letter grade.
- Student pays the graduate tuition and fees rate for these classes.
- We may accept these courses for graduate credit, once admitted to WSU's graduate school if permitted by the department.
- The student will need to satisfy the admissions requirements for the graduate program at Worcester State when he or she applies to a graduate program.
- Students are cautioned that graduate-level courses taken as part of their undergraduate major at Worcester State University may not transfer to other colleges as graduate credit.
- Some graduate classes may be excluded from this option.
