

Undergraduate Student Taking a Graduate Course (900-level)

Registration Approval Form

Purpose:

• To provide Worcester State University undergraduate students the ability to take a graduate level course. Senior undergraduate students may take 1 or 2 graduate-level courses, in their major area of study, before obtaining a bachelor's degree. (For example, biology majors can take graduate-level biology courses, English majors can take graduate-level English courses.)

Notes:

- In order to be eligible, undergraduate students must be in their senior year (have earned a minimum of 90 credits) and have a strong academic record.
- These courses are 900-level courses and will be listed that way on a student's transcript with a letter grade. They do not apply towards the undergraduate degree.
- Student pays the <u>graduate</u> tuition and fees rate for these classes.
- Students are cautioned that graduate-level courses taken before the student has earned a bachelor's degree may not transfer to other colleges as graduate credit.
- Some graduate courses may be excluded from this option.
