## INTENSIVE PROGRAM (FULL OR PART TIME)

Intensive program students study academic English up to 20 hours per week to rapidly improve their fluency and competency. Core courses focus on reading, writing, listening, speaking, pronunciation, grammar, and preparation for the TOEFL iBT examination. The full time program fulfills requirements for an F-1 visa.

## COURSE OFFERINGS

SEPTEMBER 6, 2023 – DECEMBER 15, 2023

<b>Reading &amp; Writing: Mon &amp; Wed</b>	<b>8:15 a.m.–12:15 p.m.</b>	\$1,550
Study and practice reading and writing to reach college entry level proficiency. Beginning students start with vocabulary and sentence structure. Advanced students learn to understand college level texts, novels, and other reading materials as well as being taught essay and research writing. Reading and Writing requires two days of study.		
<b>Listening &amp; Speaking: Tues</b>	<b>1–5 p.m.</b>	\$775
Students practice giving speeches, presentations, and conversation to develop fluency, build vocabulary, and improve pronunciation in speaking English. Intermediate to upper level students receive extra help with instruction from Worcester State University graduate level students enrolled in the Communication Sciences & Disorders Department.		
<b>Grammar: Thurs</b>	<b>1–5 p.m.</b>	\$775
Learn and practice the structural relationships of words and sentences to gain confidence in the ability to speak and write English. Students are provided with opportunities to practice grammar through all avenues of skill building including reading, writing, speaking, and listening.		
<b>TOEFL iBT Preparation: Fri</b>	<b>8:15 a.m.–12:15 p.m.</b>	\$775
Intermediate to advanced level students take this course to focus on preparation for the TOEFL iBT examination. Testing strategies are discussed along with targeted practice on test areas that have proven most difficult for students.		
<b>Integrated Skills: Fri</b>	<b>8:15 a.m.–12:15 p.m.</b>	\$775
Students have the opportunity to reinforce and improve with use of all five of the skills areas in language through an integrated, theme based approach. Students will improve their ability to use English effectively.		
<b>Bridge to University Seminar</b>	<b>TBA</b>	\$350
Mandatory support class for first-time Bridge to University students.		
<b>Special Topics</b>	<b>TBA</b>	\$775
Upper level students (levels 6 and higher) have the opportunity to increase and refine English language skills in a pragmatic integrated style. Past topics have included linguistics and US health care systems, and business English.
