


## Math Advising: Business Track




\* MA098: A course grade of C- or above earns a Code 2.
\* MA099: A course grade in the C range earns a Code 4. A course grade in the A or B range earns a Code 5.
\* MA180: A course grade of C- or above allows progression to MA202 or EC202.






- \* Math courses must be completed before Stage II.
- \* **MA098**: A course grade of C- or above earns a Code 2.
- \* **MA099**: A course grade in the C range earns a Code 4. A course grade in the A or B range earns a Code 5.

## Math Advising: Statistics Track



\* Students in Nursing, Public Health, and Occupational Studies who do not have a Placement Code of 4 can email the Math Department Chair to sign up for MA150.PI. This is a 4 credit statistics course with one developmental credit built in and no pre-requisite that is offered each Spring.

## Math Advising: STEM Track



- \* MA098: A course grade of C- or above earns a Code 2.
- \* **MA099**: A course grade in the C range earns a Code 4. A course grade in the A or B range earns a Code 5.
- \* MA180/MA190/MA200: A course grade of C- or above allows progression to the next course.

## Math Advising: MA105/MA107

\* Students in the following majors generally DO NOT need to take the placement exam:

Art, Communication, Criminal Justice, Education Studies, English, History, Liberal Studies, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish, Theatre, Urban Studies, Visual Performing Arts.

Students who have a High School GPA of at least 2.7 within the last 3 years or a Placement Code of 3 can register themselves for

MA105 Survey of Math or MA107 Math Explorations 3 credits

Students in these majors who do not meet either of the above requirements can email the Math Department Chair to get registered for

**MA105.PI** 

Survey of Math 4 credits (1 developmental credit)

 $\ast$  Pyschology majors do need to take PS275, which requires a Placement Code of 3 or a passing grade in a college level math course (such as MA105/MA107).
