


# Accessing GEMINI using WSU Account

**Step 1:** Go to <https://gemini.google.com/app>


If you're already signed in to Gmail, you'll be taken straight to **Gemini**.

If not, continue to **Step 2**.

**Step 2:** Click the **Sign In** button in the upper-right corner.




**Step 3:** Select your **WSU Gmail** account from the list.



**Step 4:** You'll be redirected to the **University login page** > enter your **WSU account credentials**.


