#### CURRENT BECKER COLLEGE THIRD-YEAR STUDENTS

Current third-year Becker College Business Administration students who will achieve senior status by the end of the spring 2021 semester in good academic standing are guaranteed enrollment in the Worcester State University Business Administration program at the senior level. The following teach-out plan is specifically designed for current Becker College third-year students who will enter the Worcester State University Business Administration program at the senior level. Satisfactory completion of the Becker College first-, second- and third-year curricula in Business Administration will guarantee students 91 credits in transfer to Worcester State University. Students will then follow the following degree requirements and timeline to finish their degrees at Worcester State University.
