#### CURRENT BECKER COLLEGE THIRD-YEAR STUDENTS

Current third-year Becker College Criminal Justice students who will achieve senior status by the end of the spring 2021 semester in good academic standing are guaranteed enrollment in the Worcester State University Criminal Justice program at the senior level. The following teach-out plan is specifically designed for current Becker College first-year students who will enter the Worcester State University Criminal Justice program at the senior level. Satisfactory completion of the Becker College first-, second- and third-year curricula in Criminal Justice will guarantee students 91 credits in transfer to WSU.
