Current Becker College Early Childhood Education (ECE) students who are in good academic standing are guaranteed enrollment in the Worcester State University ECE program. The following teach-out plan is designed for current Becker College (BC) students, with flexibility depending on the number of equivalent education courses taken at BC. Satisfactory completion of equivalent education credits at Becker College will result in up to 15 credits in transfer to WSU and additional non-education courses may also transfer to WSU. Students will then follow the following degree requirements to finish their degrees at Worcester State University.

- A second major is required for Early Childhood Education majors. Those second majors are Biology, Chemistry, English, Geography, History, Mathematics, Liberal Studies, Natural Science, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish, or Visual and Performing Arts.
- The number of LASC courses required will be based on equivalent general studies courses taken at Becker College.
- The number of second major courses needed will be based on which second major is chosen.
- Students may need to take additional courses or add a semester(s) if they have to take additional LASC or second major courses.
