For Becker College Undergraduate RN-BSN Nursing Students

CURRENT BECKER COLLEGE STUDENTS

Current Becker College RN-BSN nursing students who achieve junior status by the end of the Spring 2021 semester at BC or who achieve junior status by the end of the Spring 2022 semester at QCC in good academic standing are guaranteed enrollment in the Worcester State University Nursing program at the junior level in the Fall 2021 or Fall 2022 semester. The following teach out plan is specifically designed for current BC RN-BSN students. Satisfactory completion of the RN-BSN freshmen and sophomore years in nursing (at BC or QCC) will guarantee students 51 credits in transfer to WSU. Students will then follow the following degree requirements and timeline to finish their degrees at Worcester State University.
