Although the Scholarship Tea was cancelled due to the pandemic, more than \$10,000 was raised for scholarships to honor **Professor**Emerita Mary K. Alexander, Ed.D, a pioneering leader in nursing education.

A DIFFERENT TYPE OF OUTREACH

During COVID-19, outreach to our alumni and donors became a top priority, although we had to get creative with personal and virtual solutions.

1,421 constituents were contacted by a member of our team to check in during the uncertain time

532 donors received a personalized video thank you from a Worcester State student

896 constituents received a special outreach to show our appreciation of their donations of time, talent and/or financial resources

890 donors were acknowledged with a telephone call or note from our office within 48 hours of receiving a donation








How that money supported university priorities
