Unusual Enrollment History Review Form

You **must** submit:

- Completed Unusual Enrollment History Review Form
- Unofficial transcript from ALL prior colleges you attended in the last 4 years (or official transcript to Admissions)
- For each college listed, attach a separate explanation if you failed to earn any academic credit at that college. Attach any additional documentation (i.e. medical bills, hospital records, accident reports, etc.) that supports your reason for withdrawal.
