Student Homelessness 2025-2026

- The director or a designee of a director of a program funded under a TRIO or Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for an Undergraduate program (“GEAR UP”) grant;
- A financial aid administrator at another institution who previously made a determination.

 - Temporarily staying with others due to loss of housing, economic hardship, etc.
2. If you are staying with another household, check the circumstances that apply. **Please provide an eviction notice or statement from landlord for loss of housing, job termination or resignation letter for economic hardship, or a signed statement explaining your circumstances for “other”:**

 - Economic hardship resulting in inability to secure and maintain fixed, regular, adequate housing
 - Other (including, for example, when it is not safe for you to live with a parent or guardian, when a parent or guardian has forced you to leave home, and other situations of abuse or conflict)
